ATTENTION: FORMS MUST BE SUBMITTED Please make sure all forms (new and returning families), immunizations, and birth certificates are turned in ASAP. Reminder that all 7th grade and 12th grade students must have the boosters for TDAP and meningococcal vaccines. This is a WV State law that these students have these boosters. We must have these forms on file to keep our Exemption K and accreditation status. **You can have your doctor's office fax to 304-757-6777 for your convenience.**

PARKING LOT In order to prevent congestion and to provide a safe environment, we are asking parents to pull into a parking space at drop-off and pick-up. Please do not stop in the driving lane to pick-up or drop-off your child as this backs traffic up onto Teays Valley Road. We are also asking that parents do not to park in front of the Patriot Center or the church. Please pull into a parking space to decrease traffic and allow for emergency vehicle access.

We are pleased to inform you that **Calvary Baptist Academy**, located in Putnam County, WV, has satisfied the statutory requirement necessary to maintain the Exemption (k) status set forth in W.Va. Code §18-8-1.*
