SCIENCE LAB At the end of this month the West Virginia Farm Bureau's Mobile Agriculture Education Science Lab will be visiting CBA for the week. The lab is scheduled to be at CBA January 29th through February 2nd. Students in grades kindergarten through 6th grade will attend the science lab. The 46-foot Lab is a fully self-contained unit equipped with multiple research stations. A retired or certified teacher guides students while they conduct hands-on experiments or activities. Students learn about the importance of agriculture in everyday living. They will do experiments, learn to read nutrition labels, discover which snacks are healthier for their bodies, and what food choices will promote healthy lifestyles. Some of the experiments include making "Glue from Milk" and comparing it to commercial glue; understanding the concept of environmental impact by making "Plastic from Corn" instead of from petroleum; and seeing if they can extract DNA from a strawberry and why a farmer would want to do that.
